

**AT A MEETING OF THE TRUSTEES DATED 26 MARCH, 2015**

**RESOLUTION OF THE TRUSTEES OF THE DIOCESE OF NATAL**

**RESOLVED: -**

That the Parish Council shall have authority as listed in part 24 (6)(a) - (f) of the Acts of the Diocese of Natal (copy attached) which authority shall be subject to articles XVIII and XIX of the Constitution; Canons of the Province and Rules of the Diocese.

The Parish Council is vested with authority to deal with any other matter not mentioned below save as may be contrary to the Constitution, Canons of the Province and rules of the Diocese including Bylaws promulgated by the Bishop and the Parish Manual which, are to be strictly adhered to.

The Parish Council does not have authority on the matters as set out below:-

1. To sell, donate, exchange or alienate the land and the buildings vested in the Trustees as per Act 17 (1) of the Acts of the Diocese of Natal and as mentioned in the Constitution, Canons of the Province and the Rules of the Diocese;
2. To purchase any immovable property;
3. To receive any immovable property in any manner whatsoever;
4. To lease or to let any property save with the consent of the Trustees;
5. To effect any alterations and/or additions to the land and buildings vested in the Trustees save with the consent of the Trustees.
  - 5.1 In the event that alterations and/or additions to the land and buildings are required and are of necessity, then in that event, the approval of the Trustees shall be sought and obtained prior to the commencement of such alterations and/or additions.
  - 5.2 The Bishop's faculty must first be obtained before any monument, mural tablet, stained glass window, piece of furniture, musical instrument or other adornment is installed or removed from any Church. The prerequisite for the granting of such a faculty is a joint application to the Bishop signed by the Archdeacon, the Incumbent and the Churchwardens.
